Sufism

The best way to describe Sufism is to say, it is the School of Self Knowledge. It teaches its students to discover their hidden talents and abilities; expand their perception; break the boundaries of limitation; and ultimately journey through the heavens of their being.²

Enlightenment

Symbolically, the goal of Sufism is union with God. Sufi Masters have often described this union as like a drop of water becoming one with the ocean. When the drop of water loses its boundaries in the ocean's depth, the drop is no longer a separate drop of water, but it is one with the ocean. Like the drop, the lover of God is annihilated in union with the Beloved. Union provides enlightenment.³
